What is Adult Family Care?

Adult Family Care (AFC) is a unique program that enables caregivers to assist older adults and individuals with disabilities to thrive at home.

- Care in a Family Setting: Caregivers and participants share a home, fostering a close and supportive bond.
- Flexibility in Placements: Participants may live with approved caregivers, including relatives (excluding spouses, guardians, or power of attorney holders).

Assurance (NCQA) in the area of Case Management for Long Term Services and Supports. This accreditation demonstrates our commitment to quality service for those we serve, their caregivers, and our health care partners.
